## Courtesy Notice: Requirement to Submit Hazardous Materials Plan (HMP)

Requirement

Hazardous Materials Plans (HMPs) are required by state law for all businesses that store, handle, use or otherwise maintain reportable quantities of hazardous materials/hazardous wastes on site at any one time.

Reportable quantity thresholds are: 55 gallons, 500 pounds, or 200 cubic feet. Visit <a href="https://www.emd.saccounty.net/EC/HM/Pages/BusinessPlans.aspx">www.emd.saccounty.net/EC/HM/Pages/BusinessPlans.aspx</a> for definitions and exceptions.

What you must do

Your business has been identified as one that is subject to HMP requirements. You must submit your completed HMP documents within 60 days. HMPs are submitted electronically using the California Environmental Reporting System (CERS).

How to submit the HMP

**First time users**: Please visit <u>cers.calepa.ca.gov</u> to create a CERS account, request access to your facility, and complete the required HMP forms.

**Existing CERS users**: Log into your account at cers.calepa.ca.gov to review/edit your previous submission. You must resubmit the entire HMP annually even if there are no changes to your previous HMP submission.

To avoid penalties

Please visit <a href="https://cersbusiness.calepa.ca.gov/Help">https://cersbusiness.calepa.ca.gov/Help</a> for answers to commonly asked questions regarding CERS submittals. Failure to submit your completed HMP by the due date shown at the top of this letter will result in up to \$5000.00 / day in civil penalties. Payment of your annual permit fees does not relieve you of the requirement to submit your HMP.
