- case. I called Ed Vasques, Battalion 2, and he stated he thought there may be an enforcement case. I told him I would call Ken Hawkswood, Haz Mat Specialist, and ask him. Chief Vasques asked me to have Mr. Hawkswood call him on the radio at Fire Comm B 2. I tried to call Jim Frank, Supervising Haz Mat Specialist and Mr. Hawkswood and neither were home. I contacted Elise Rothschild, Haz Mat Specialist, and she said she would call Chief Vasques and call me back if we were going to respond.
- 2035 Ms. Rothschild called me back and told me she would meet me at the facility.
- I arrived on scene at the Unlimited Apparatus shop at 8516 Fruitridge Rd. City Fire, City Haz Mat and Ms. Rothschild were on scene when I arrived. The fire was out and the building was being vented to get rid of the smoke. Ms. Rothschild interviewed the owner of the business and I took pictures of the oven. I noticed the bottom 1/3 to 1/4 of a 55 gallon drum with three one gallon metal containers in it setting in the middle of the oven. It appeared that some of the material inside the one gallon containers had boiled out and had the drum bottom partially filled. The material looked charred with what appeared to be white crystals on one part of the material. I went to an area in the back of the shop and took pictures of numerous drums that were being stored in an open shed. The drums were without hazardous waste labels and two drums were missing tops. I counted 32 full or partially full drums that were stored in or around the shed.
- 2240 Samples were taken from the containers that were in the oven.
- 2250 I cleared the scene.
